

Directions to the Slippery Rock Creek

Slippery Rock Creek is located in Western PA, east of New Castle. It takes about an hour and a half from the Streetsboro entrance to the Ohio Turnpike (RT 80)

1. Take the Ohio turnpike toward Pennsylvania.
2. When the turnpike changes to Rt76, stay on Rt 80 (exiting the turnpike)
3. Take Rt 80 into PA, and exit at Rt 60 (exit 218)
4. Follow PA Rt 60 south for about 12.5 miles and take Exit 4A toward New Castle.
5. Take US422 east for about 10-11 miles; watch for exit in middle
6. Then turn right and take US19 south a little less than 2 miles.
7. Then turn right on Cheeseman Road (look for sign that says "Breakneck Camping", as road sign is hard to see).
8. Follow the road until you see Cheeseman Camp Ground on the left.

We will meet at Cheeseman's Camp Ground.

Over night camping is available, if you are interested.
